



## **Pre-Sale Inspection**

A Pre-Sale Inspection is a service EPI offers for sellers to use in order to ensure that the most accurate representation of their vehicles is announced at the time of sale. EPI will visually and mechanically inspect the vehicle. This inspection will allow EPI to make the necessary announcements found under Appendix 1 of the NAAA Seller Disclosure/ Announcement requirements. This helps both the buyer and the seller avoid arbitration. Sellers will get the most money for their vehicles by properly announcing the vehicle which in turn builds a strong following of their vehicles. Pre-Sale inspected vehicles also increase your potential buyer base as the likelihood of one of your vehicles selling online is dramatically increased when it has been inspected. Arbitration can become very costly to a seller when you include the time lost, the possibility of refunding the buyer for transportation costs, and the fees applied by EPI due to the misrepresentation of a vehicle.

\*A Pre-Sale inspected vehicle does not provide any additional protection to the buyer outside the posted time periods found in Appendix 1 in the NAAA Arbitration Policy. The purchase of a BPP- (Buyer Protection Plan) can extend coverage for the buyer. The purchase of a Pre-Sale inspection does not release the seller of all responsibility of properly announcing their vehicle as not all items subject to Arbitration can be detected during this inspection\*
